A roundabout at the Chiltern Hospital junction has been the subject of many debates over the years.

Now is the opportunity, with the road safety fund from HS2, to get this built and this could be the only opportunity!

The parish council needs everyone's support if this is what you the community want.

The traffic on the A413 is going to increase not only from HS2 vehicles but also because of the increased housing development

further north. The number of HS2 lorries (HGVs) could reach 600 per day going north and south, and those figures do not include vehicles under 7.5 tons.

In addition, The Misbourne school is expanding to take in an additional 120 students. At present there are 1,800 pupils attending the schools in Great Missenden.
